39:1 And Joseph was brought down to Egypt; and Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him of the hands of the Ishmeelites, which had brought him down thither.

2 And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

3 And his master saw that the LORD was with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.

4 And Joseph found grace in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house, and all that he had he put into his hand.

6. I associate with those who are blessed and highly favored so that I may increase in every area of my life.

Gen 30:27

27 And Laban said unto him, I pray thee, if I have found favour in thine eyes, tarry: for I have learned by experience that the LORD hath blessed me for thy sake. KJV

7. I operate in integrity; as a result, I obtain favor from God.

Prov 11:27

27 He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him. KJV

Prov 12:2

2 A good man obtaineth favour of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn. KJV

8. I actively seek and live by God's wisdom; therefore, I am highly favored and esteemed in the sight of God and men.

10. The Lord takes pleasure in my prosperity. He desires for me to prosper in every area of my life – spiritually, financially, emotionally, physically, mentally and socially.

27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. KJV

3 John 2

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. KJV

11. The favor of God shields me; therefore, no sickness or disease can live in my body.

12. Wealth and riches are in my house because I am empowered with God's anointing and favor to draw wealth.

Deut 8:18

that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day. KJV

Ps 112:3

3 Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever. KJV

Exodus 23:25

*But you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and your water; and **I will remove sickness from your midst**. NASB*

Luke 9:11b

He (Jesus) welcomed them (the crowds) and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who needed healing.

Hebrews 10:7

Lo, I come, to do thy will, O God.

John 6:38

I (Jesus) came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

The Leper of Mark 1:40 said:

If you are willing, you can make me clean.

Filled with compassion, Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. *I am willing*, he said, *Be clean!*

James 5:14-16

*Is **ANYONE** among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him,*

*anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer offered in faith **WILL** restore the one who is sick, and the Lord **WILL** raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they **WILL** be forgiven him. Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.*

Matthew 12:15

*Great multitudes followed him (Jesus), and he healed them **ALL**.*

Matthew 14:36

*As many as touched (HIM) were made **perfectly whole**.*

Luke 6:19

*The whole multitude sought to touch him; (and He) healed them **ALL**.*

Matthew 8:16-17

*. . .and He . . .healed **ALL** that were sick: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying, Himself took **OUR** infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.*

Hebrews 13:8

*Jesus Christ **THE SAME** yesterday, and to day, and for ever.*

Psalms 89:34

God says, *MY covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.*

Psalm 30:2, 3

*O Lord my God, I called to YOU for help and **YOU healed me.** O Lord, you brought me up from the grave; you spared me from going down into the pit.*

Psalm 149:4 NASB

*For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the afflicted ones with **SALVATION.***

The writers of the Bible did not write in English. English hadn't even been invented yet. In certain places in the Bible the original word we translate into English as "salvation" is the same word which we also translate into English as the word "healing!" He can "save" and/or "heal" both the body and the spirit!

Jeremiah 17:14

*Heal me, O Lord, and **I WILL BE HEALED;** save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise.*

Luke 4:40

*When the sun was setting, **ALL** they that had **ANY** sick with divers diseases brought them unto him;*

*and he laid his hands on **EVERY ONE OF THEM**
and **HEALED THEM**.*

Luke 10:9

Jesus said to His disciples, When you enter a town... Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God is near you.'

Sometimes we are to heal the sick before we are even to preach!

Isaiah 53:4-5

*Surely he (Jesus) took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows,. . .by his wounds we **ARE** healed.*

John 16:23

Whatsoever you shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.

Mark 11:24

What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them.

Matthew 8:14-15

And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever. And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.

Matt. 18:19

***IF TWO OF YOU SHALL AGREE** on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.*

One of God's names in the Old Testament Hebrew is Jehovah-Rapha. This is found in Exodus 15:26.

HIS Name translates from the Hebrew: "GOD THE HEALER." HIS NAME IS "HEALER" BECAUSE HEALING IS IN HIS VERY NATURE

Psalms 103:1-5

*Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget none of His benefits; Who pardons ALL your iniquities; **Who heals ALL your diseases**; Who redeems your life from the pit; Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion; Who satisfies your years with good things, So that **your youth is renewed like the eagle.***

Getting your YOUTH RENEWED is healing.

Isaiah 40:29-31

HE giveth power to the faint; and TO THEM that have no might HE increaseth strength.** Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: But **THEY THAT WAIT UPON THE LORD** [minister to, wait upon, turn to, focus on, pray to, believe in] shall **RENEW

THEIR STRENGTH; *they shall mount up with wings as eagles*; ***THEY SHALL RUN***, and not be weary; and ***THEY SHALL WALK***, and not faint.
If you can RUN and not get tired and walk and not faint, that is healing!

1st Peter 2:24

And He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; FOR BY HIS WOUNDS YOU WERE HEALED.

Notice "were" is past tense. From God's perspective you've already received healing.

1 Corinthians 15:53-54

For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

Acts 10:38

*How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and **HEALING ALL** that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.*

Jesus is not recorded to have **turned ANYONE away** who sought healing.

John 10:10

Jesus said that HE came *that they might have life and have it more abundantly.*

John 14:6 and

John 11:25

He said, *I AM the . . .life. . . itself.*

Prosperity Scriptures
